- Order from the constitutional court (highest judicial tribunal) for the formalization of the informal recycling sector.

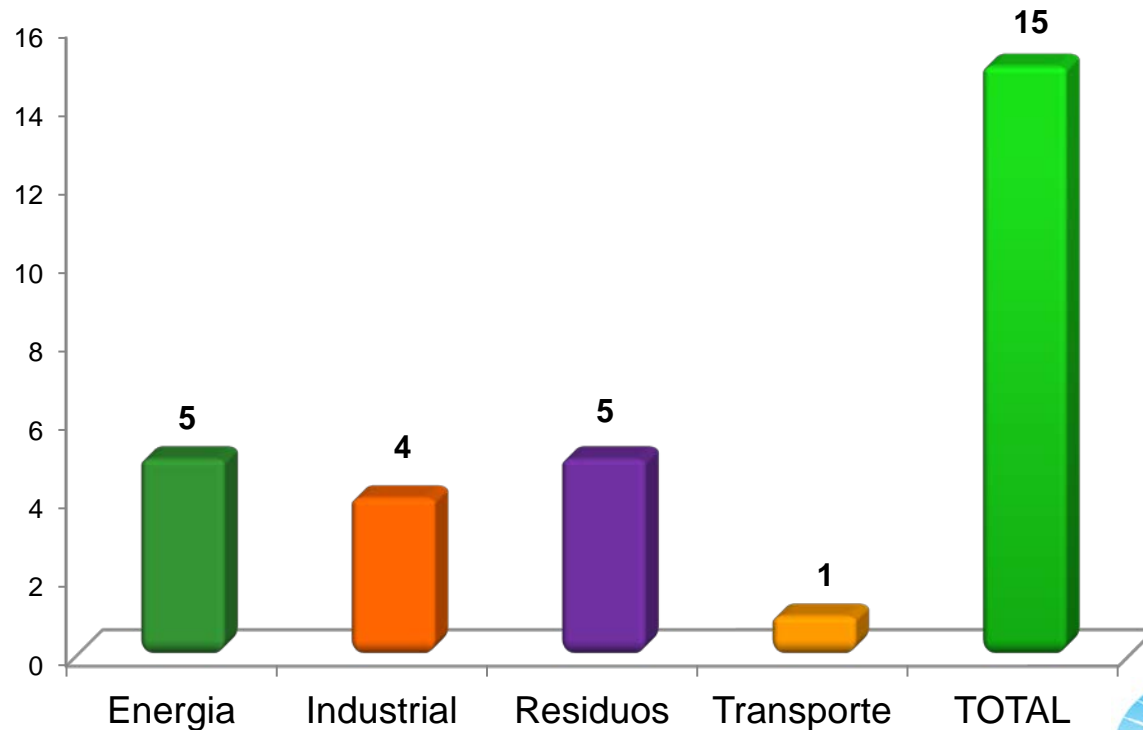
- Colombian Low Carbon Development Strategy

Colombian Update: National Solid Waste Plans

- Colombian Low Carbon Development Strategy
 - Initial phase is almost finished (marginal abatement cost curves, initial list of mitigation actions prioritized by sector stakeholders).
 - End of 2013: Sector action plan must be established.
 - Ministry of Housing, City and Territories (in charge of the public utility).
 - Priorization of the sector of mitigation actions for implementation.

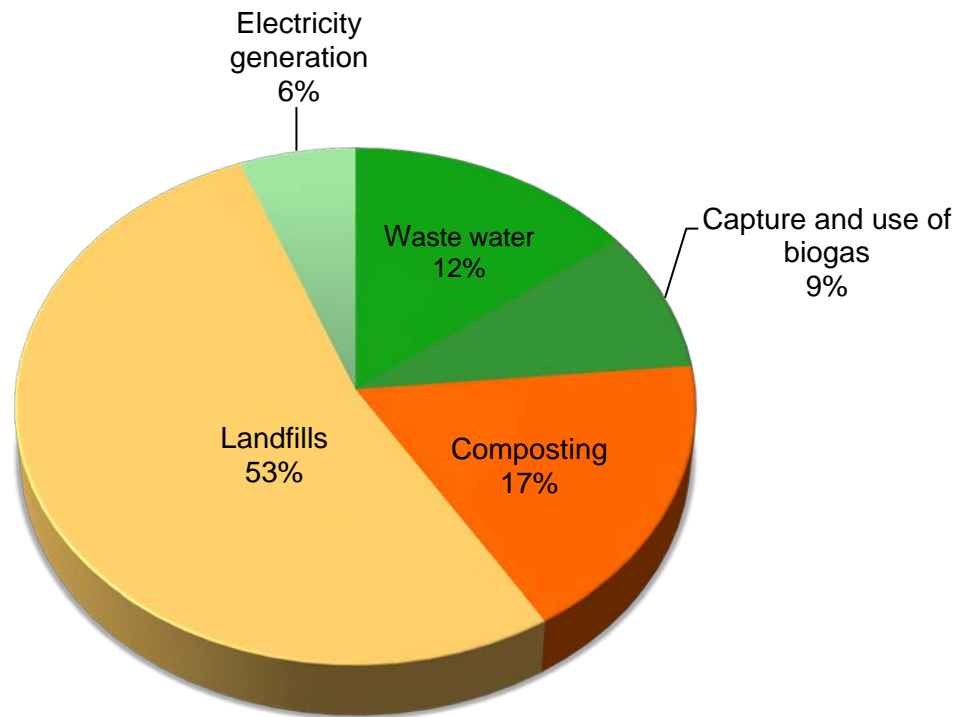

Methane Action Plan

- Not yet finished.
- Awaiting for final results of the Colombian Low Carbon Development Strategy to be officially published.

Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMA) - I

- Integrated Solid Waste NAMA
- Components Phase I:
 - Scoping studies for prioritization of mitigation actions
- Components Phase II:
 - Analysis of technological options for diversion of waste from landfilling (MBT, RDF, composting)
 - Policy and incentives (inclusion of price of recycling activities in tariffs, policy that permits use of new technologies, extended producer responsibility is important but not yet included in the process).
 - Informal sector inclusion within the waste management activities.

Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMA) - II

- Cooperating agencies
 - Financing from the Government of Canada (Environment Canada)
 - Technical support of the Center for Clean Air Policy (CCAP).
