Laws and Regulations

Laws and regulations are official legal document of government

such as administrative regulations enacted and promulgated by the State Council of the People's Republic of China, local laws and regulations enacted and promulgated by the people's congress and its standing committee of provinces, autonomous regions, and municipalities directly under the central government. People's congress of cities where the people's governments of provinces and autonomous regions are located, and people's congress and its standing committee of relatively large cities with the approval of the State Council can also enact local laws and regulations, and reported to people's congress and its standing committee of provinces, autonomous regions before implementation.

Laws and regulations are of enforcement and constraint

Order of Laws and Regulations

Constitution of the People's Republic of China is enacted and amended by the National People's Congress.
Fundamental laws, such as the Criminal Law, are enacted and amended by the National People's Congress.
Other laws (general laws or common laws) are enacted and amended by the standing committee of the National People's Congress.
Administrative regulations are enacted and amended by the State council.
Local laws and regulations are enacted and amended by the standing committee of the people's congress of provinces and municipalities directly under the central government.
Autonomous rules and regulations are enacted and amended by the standing committee of the people's congress of autonomous regions.
Departmental rules are low-level laws and implemented within its own jurisdiction scope, which is enacted by the ministries, committees, bureaus and offices of State Council, and approved by State Council.



Standard: Technical Specification

- National standards are nationwide technical requirements.
- Four types of standards: national standards, sectoral standards, local standards and enterprise standards.
- Two categories of national standards: compulsory national standards (GB) and recommended national standards (GB/T).
- General term of validity for national standards is 5 years, and national standards should be amended or renewed after expiration.
