

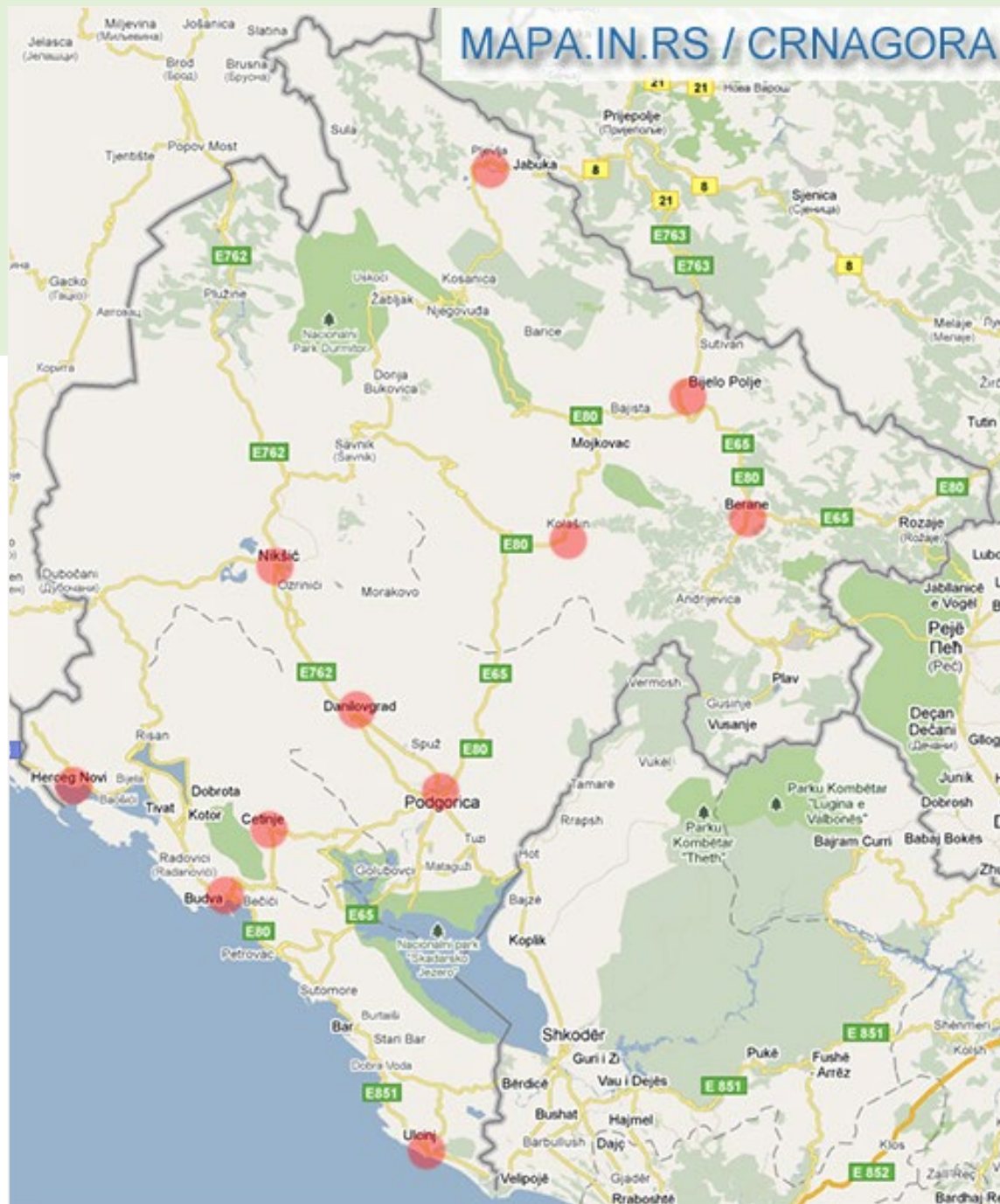


1. I come from a country that has solved the problem of waste disposal.

With two clicks, they will be able to report what they don't like, and the services will have to respond within 24/48 hours**

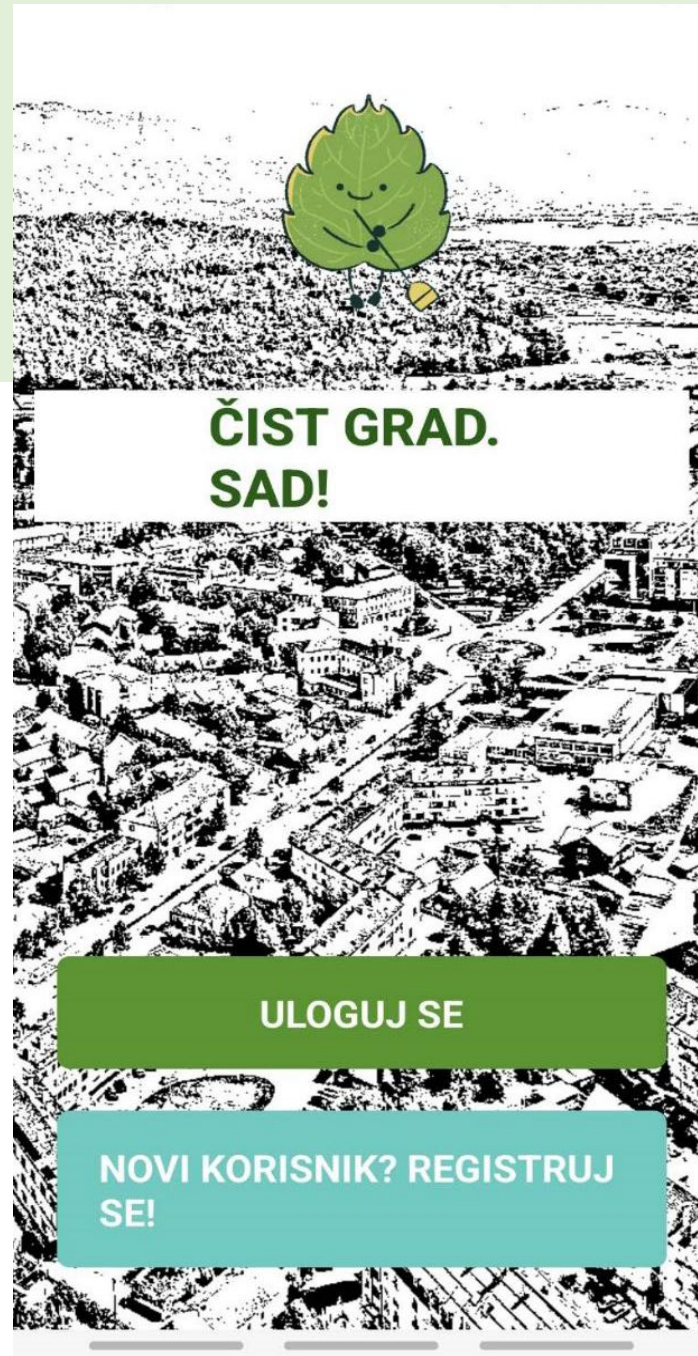
