

Criteria for GMI Strategic Partners

An organization should meet the following criteria in order to be considered as a Strategic Partner:

- The organization's mission or function aligns with achieving methane mitigation internationally.
- The organization has demonstrated an interest in participating or is already participating in GMI activities.
- Coordination and collaboration with the organization are mutually beneficial.

A Strategic Partner agrees to the following:

- The organization may send a representative to be an official observer at GMI Steering
 Committee meetings. The representative should be empowered to speak on behalf of the
 organization and to suggest areas for collaboration. GMI's Terms of Reference state that official
 observers are welcome to offer ideas and perspectives but may not participate in decisionmaking activities of the Steering Committee.
- The organization will meet with GMI 1-2 times per year to discuss opportunities for collaboration and achieving mutual goals.
- The organization will invite GMI or a GMI representative to participate in their methane-related meetings, events, etc., as appropriate.
- The organization may allow GMI to use their logo on GMI's website or other materials where GMI lists Strategic Partners, or when GMI co-hosts events.
- The organization is **not** required to sign a Memorandum of Understanding or any other formal document in order to be a GMI Strategic Partner.
